





To make this recipe, you will need:

- Uncooked Chicken Breasts,
- Chinese Cabbage,
- Sesame Seed ()il,
- Short Grain White Rice,
- **Tamaci (this is a kind of sweet soy sauce**),
- Sugar,
- Oranges and,
- Stir Fry Vegetable<mark>s.</mark>

- 1. Start preparing the white rice.
- 2. Mix one tablespoon of sesame seed oil into half a cup of tamari. Squeeze in some juice from the oranges to make it tangy, and add sugar if it is too sweet. This will be the marinade for the chicken
- 3. Take the chicken breasts, and cut them up into little cubes. But them in a frying pan and start mixing it around with a wooden spoon. Wait until they turn a light pink or white color.
- 4. Get the marinade and mix in all of it. The chicken will turn a dark golden color.
- 5. Stir the chicken around some more until it has sucked up all of the marinade.
- 6. Wait for the rice to finish, and take the chicken off of the stove.
- 7. Seat up the stir fry vegetables. Y ou can make a little more marinade for this if you like, or just use some that was left over from making the chicken.
- 8. Serve the rice, then put the chicken and Chinese cabbage on top along with the stir fry. Enjoy!







What you need to make the periscope: Two short toilet paper tubes, One long paper towel tube, tape, two small mirrors that can fit through the toilet paper tube or just some mirror cardboard that they sell at most craft stores, and pressed or fake plants for decorating.

To make the periscope you need too cut diagonally on the three cardboard paper tubes as shown. Take the mirrors, and put tape on them. Tape them to the inside of the long paper tube so that on the bottom the shiny side is facing up, and on the top the shiny side is facing down. Then, tape the other piece of tape (this might be a little tricky) to the corresponding shorter cardboard tube. Tape the tubes together firmly. If you like, decorate your periscope with vines and other plants. It will make it harder to see if you use it outside behind a hedge.




